Pennsylvania Retail Trade Embraces the Holiday Season

MIDDLETOWN, Pa - With less than a week remaining until Christmas, Pennsylvania businesses have risen to the challenge of filling the purchasing needs of shoppers throughout the state. The Pennsylvania State Data Center at Penn State Harrisburg reports that according to the 1997 Economic Census, there were 50,208 retail trade establishments in Pennsylvania in 1997 with over 650,000 paid employees. Retail trade establishments generated nearly \$110 billion in sales in Pennsylvania in 1997.

Gift Ideas from Pennsylvania's Retail Establishments

Still haven't gotten around to getting that computer for the family? You're in luck! There were 1,839 electronics and appliances stores in Pennsylvania in 1997 with 12,781 paid employees. These stores generated more than \$2 billion in sales in 1997. Of these establishments, 734 were radio, television and other electronic stores; 421 were computer and software stores; and 179 were camera and photographic supplies stores.

Looking for that best-selling novel or the latest musical selection from your favorite artist? Pennsylvania will be happy to oblige. The 537 bookstores in Pennsylvania in 1997 generated more than \$545 million in sales with nearly 4,900 paid employees. There were also 389 music stores (CDs, tapes and records) that generated over \$307 million in sales with 5,169 paid employees.

During the winter vacation season, you may have time to catch up on sports-related activities and other hobbies. Sporting good stores accounted for 1,023 retail establishments in Pennsylvania in 1997 with 6,833 paid employees and sales of \$749 million. There were 512 hobby, toy and game stores in Pennsylvania in 1997 that generated more than \$704 million in sales and had 5,169 paid employees.

Are you planning to bring a pet home for the holidays? Or perhaps you need to get presents and food for an existing non-human family member. There were 402 pet and pet supplies establishments in Pennsylvania in 1997, generating \$212.8 million in sales with 2,765 paid employees.

Looking for an uncommon present? Look no farther than Pennsylvania. There were 1,623 gift, novelty and souvenir stores in Pennsylvania in 1997 with 9,640 paid employees and sales of nearly \$624 million.

Of course, there are always those who appreciate receiving clothing and accessories for the holidays. There were 4,007 clothing stores, 1,523 shoe stores and 1,319 jewelry stores in Pennsylvania in 1997. Combined sales generated nearly \$6 billion with 55,894 paid employees.

If you're not willing to face the holiday crowds and would prefer to shop from home, there were 412 electronic shopping and mail order establishments in Pennsylvania in 1997. These establishments generated \$6.6 billion in sales with 15,192 paid employees.

You may need to stock up on supplies for a party. There were 2,957 supermarkets and grocery stores, 1,374 specialty food stores and 1,561 beer, wine and liquor stores in Pennsylvania in 1997. More than 1,300 convenience stores were available in 1997 for those last-minute items. In total, food and beverage establishments had 152,042 paid employees and generated more than \$19 billion in annual sales.

The holidays are not complete without flowers. There were 1,272 Pennsylvania florists with 6,264 paid employees in 1997. These establishments generated more than \$307 million in sales.

County Statistics

At the county level (Table 1.), Allegheny County had the largest number of establishments (5,353) and sales from retail trade (\$12.9 billion) of all the counties in Pennsylvania in 1997. Philadelphia County was second in number of establishments (4,782), and Montgomery County was second in sales (\$9.6 billion). Allegheny County also had the largest number of paid employees in retail trade (78,841), followed by Montgomery County (54,728) and Philadelphia County (51,398).
