2000 County-to-County Worker Flow Commuter Files: Where Do People Work and Where Do People Live

MIDDLETOWN, Pa – The Pennsylvania State Data Center at Penn State Harrisburg reports that the U.S. Census Bureau has released Census 2000 County-to-County Worker Flow files. These files were compiled from responses to Census 2000 long-form questionnaires on where people worked. These files allow users to look at the number of people who work in a county during the reference week and determine where they reside whether in an adjacent county or in another state. The data is available at the county level for the United States, individual states and the District of Columbia.

Of all Pennsylvania commuters, the most common county-to-county trip in 2000 was from Philadelphia County to Montgomery County. Nearly 60,000 individuals were involved in this commute (Tables 1 & 2). The Montgomery County to Philadelphia County commute (54,576) was the next most common, followed by Westmoreland County to Allegheny County (43,536) and Northampton County to Lehigh County (30,180).

There were 258,360 Pennsylvanians who traveled out of the state to work in 2000. The majority of Pennsylvania workers traveled to New Jersey (111,496), followed by Maryland (41,056), New York (36,742) and Delaware (27,156). There were 205,882 individuals who traveled to the commonwealth to work in 2000. The majority of out-of-state workers came from New Jersey (117,184), followed by Delaware (21,687), New York (13,758) and Ohio (13,400).

Only Montour County had more people commuting into the county to work than it did residents who worked in the county. There were 4,716 workers in Montour County who both resided and worked in the county in 2000. There were 6,951 commuters who traveled into Montour County to work in 2000.
